

Position: Head Electrician Gusman Theater

Qualifications: Professional stage/theatrical electricians, theatrical and entertainment stage lighting experience, including lighting design and experience as a head or assistant stage electrician. Leadership, and experience managing load in and show crews of 4-16 IATSE electricians is a must.

Responsibilities: Supervises all electricians crews for load-in, set up, operation and load-out of all stage productions. The head electrician supervises electrical, and video crews during all work/maintenance calls.

Operating and maintaining all theatre electrical systems. Operating, repairing, and maintaining all stage lighting, house lighting and video equipment. Including but not limited to lighting fixtures, house circuits, cabling, follow spots, light boards, dimmers, video projector, video playback devices, and video switcher.

The Head Electrician works with the Assistant Theater Director, Operations and Technical Manager, Head Carpenter, Head Audio Engineer, and House Flyman in discussing the daily schedule to determine safest and most efficient use of crew and resources.

Crossing over departmental lines to assist in the areas of video, carpentry, flies, properties, and sound is a must for a well rounded member of the house crew.

The position requires managerial skills to lead, oversee and work as a team with all employees and presenters of the Gusman.
